Slide 10: Adam and Seth

Gen 5: 1-4 and Luke 3: 38 tell us that Adam was the direct creation and son of God and made in God's _____, and Seth was the son of Adam and made in Adam's _____, which at this point was _____ into sin.

Gen 5: 1-5 The first name, Adam, means "_____".

Seth - Gen 5: 3-8 Adam's son was named Seth, which means "_____." When he was born Eve said, "For God hath appointed me another seed instead of Abel, whom Cain slew."

Enosh -Gen 5: 6-11 Seth's son was called Enosh, which means "_____, frail, _____." It is from the root *anash*: to be incurable; used of a wound, grief, woe, sickness, or wickedness. (= miserably wicked)

Kenan - Gen 5: 9-14 Enosh's son was named Kenan, from which can mean "_____, " **dirge,** " (**elegy or lament**)."

Mahalalel - Gen 5: 12-17 Kenan's son was Mahalalel, from *ma-halal*, which = "blessed" or "praise"; and *El*, = God. Thus, Mahalalel means "**the Blessed** _____."

Jared - Gen 5: 15-20 Mahalalel's son was named Jared, from the verb *yaradh*, = "shall _____ down."

Enoch - Gen 5: 19-24 Jared's son was named Enoch, = "the commencement of _____ (about God)." He was the 1st of 4 generations of preaching-prophets. The Bible's earliest recorded prophecy was by Enoch who was given a prophecy that when his God-fearing son died, the JUDGMENT of the flood would fall.

Methuselah Gen 5: 21-27 The name Methuselah signifies, "his _____ shall bring." **Lamech** - Gen 5: 26-31 Methuselah's son was named Lamech, a root still evident today in our own English word, "_____" or "lamentation," and also "_____."

Noah Gen 5: 29-32- Lamech is the father of Noah, which is derived from *nacham*, "to bring _____" or "_____,"
