Dt. 5: 28-30 (ESV) The Omniscient God Knows the Fickle Hearts

We need to hear, learn and observe, that is _____ the commands and statutes. Take time for regular consistent meditation on the statutes. First and foremost is the study of the Word of God, and second, regular reading of the Founding Documents, to know, understand, apply and if necessary enforce the commands and statutes. (Jos.1:8, Ps. 1: 1-2, 119: 77-79)

Dt. 5: 31-33 (ESV) Do All the Lord has Commanded You

George Washington stated, “It is the duty of all NATIONS to _____ the providence of Almighty God, to obey His will, to be grateful for His benefits and humbly to implore His protection and favor. (Ps. 9: 17)

The Founding Fathers would not have supported any public policy that would prohibit the expression of acknowledging our sovereign God, and lead the nation to forget God, and face the loss of His _____ hand.

Help us lead our Nation to have a love for hearing, learning and obeying God’s Word, and our Founding Documents: The Declaration of Independence, The Constitution and the Bill of Rights.

2D + 3F = 3BR. The Dynamic Decalogue (Ten Commandments) and the Foundation in Faith of the Founders is summarized by the Biblical Basis of the Bill of Rights.

Dt. 5: 1-4 Hear, Learn and Obey the Law

There are 4 spheres of Jurisdiction established in the Bible:

- 1. Individual
- 2. Family
- 3. Civil Government
- 4. Church

There are 4 types of Law in the Bible:

- 1. Ceremonial
- 2. Moral
- 3. Judicial
- 4. Social Compact

Dt. 5: 1-4 (ESV) See, hear, know and apply

The mandates pertaining to moral behavior, what is right and wrong, apply to all four. Each area must stay in their own lane. What God has _____ to the family, the government has no right to infringe on. The Church does not have the sword of punishment. The mission of the church is to teach the relationship with God.

Dt. 5: 1-4 (ESV) Hear, Learn and Obey

The ceremonial law applied to the _____ rites and ceremonies to be observed by the Jews. The ceremonial laws of sacrifices, temple worship, diet: clean and unclean, and purification these are no longer applicable as they were perfectly fulfilled by Jesus Christ. (Heb 10:4-14)

The moral law is timeless, _____ and universal. It defines right and wrong. John Witherspoon a signer of the Declaration of Independence stated "The Ten Commandments... are the sum of the Moral Laws."

Dt. 5: 1-4 (ESV) Keep things in right order

Judicial law is the civil and statutory laws that _____ the penalties for the violations of the Moral Law.

Social Compact Laws are laws brought about to give _____, such as speed limits, driving lanes, food and drug labels. Blackstone noted that government is free to set its own Social Compact Law only in areas where God has not already explicitly defined the boundaries.

Dt. 5:5 I declared to you the word of the Lord

The Founders intent for The Bill of Rights was that it did not create rights but was designed to _____ rights that preexisted the document, our Inalienable God given rights, enumerated in the Bible, with the 10 Commandments at the foundation, and resting on the Foundation stone, Jesus Christ.

Before any man can be considered as a member of Civil Society, he must be considered as a subject of the Great Governor of the Universe; And if a member of Civil Society, who enters into any subordinate Association, must always do it with a reservation of his duty to the general authority; much more must every man who becomes a member of any particular Civil Society, do it with a saving of his _____ to the Universal Sovereign.

Dt. 5: 5-21 (ESV) 2D + 3F = 3BR

The First Amendment language is in absolute terms: "Congress shall make no law respecting an _____ of religion, or prohibiting the free exercise thereof". Our relationship with God is outside the realm of the government. Psalm 24:1 The earth is the Lord's and all that fills it.

The rights of the 1st amendment grant constitutional security in recognition of the people as sovereigns, not the government, in which the people retain a residual _____ to ensure that their elected and appointed official serve the people, and not vice versa.

The Second Amendment rights _____ the right of the People to keep and bear arms, without exception. It's a right not just for self-defense, but for the defense of the nation against tyranny.

The 3rd, 4th and 5th Amendments are designed to protect the people's right to _____ The 3rd amendment right preventing the government from quartering soldiers in our home, protects the jurisdictional rights of the individual and family property above the demands of the civil government from violating the 5th-10th Commandments and amendments.

The rights of the second portion of the 5th amendment and the 6th and 7th amendments are designed to ensure that civil government's enforcement powers are _____ by the rule of law even in the most heinous of crimes, covered in Deuteronomy 17.

The 8th amendment protects against excessive bail or fines or cruel and unusual punishments, and are based on the biblical principle that punishment is to be _____ to the blameworthiness of the perpetrator and the harm to the victim.

Read together the 9th and 10th amendments make it clear that the People _____ their civil sovereignty, and that their State governments are their civil rulers of all matters not specifically granted to the national government. (Lk. 22: 25-26).
