Two pagan practices: Cutting and Shaving the Forehead for the dead.

To shed one's own blood would be a way of demonstrating, through mourning for the dead, that the life was lost and there was no hope.

To shave one's forehead was equally objectionable because the forehead is the place of conscience and identification; and an acknowledgement that the conscience and identification of the dead was forever lost.

This tenth portion is Holy to the Lord, dedicated to Him and is to be the firstfruits, i.e., the best/first portion.

The TITHE is an _____ rate, paid by all.

First fruits instructs us to give to the Lord first, He will provide for the remainder of our needs.

Moses instituted the laws of TITHING to the Nation. (LV 26, NM 18, DT 12, 14, 26)

Dt. 14:26 Spend The Money For Whatever You Desire

God instituted one TITHE to be _____ three ways:

1. Shared with the Levite for his service at the temple and to the people. The Levite was to give a full tithe to the priest.
2. A portion of the tithe was to be used by the people to keep the festivals.
3. The poor and needy were to be remembered on a regular basis.

The tithe payer was to _____ how to share the tithe: An individual decision done with a willing heart.

T = Tenth (1/10th)

I = Individual decision

T = Terms of God

H = Holy to the Lord

E = Equal rate for all
